

Tax Return Information Disclosure Request

Federal law requires this consent form be provided to you. Unless authorized by law, we cannot disclose, without your consent, your tax return information to third parties for purposes other than the preparation and filing of your tax return. If you consent to the disclosure of your tax return information, Federal law may not protect your tax return information from further use or distribution.

Pursuant to Internal Revenue Service Treas. Regs. §301.7216-3, the Taxpayer authorizes the Tax Preparer to provide the Requesting Party with the designated tax information below.

The Tax Preparer understands that the tax information requested below may not be disclosed or used by the Tax Preparer for any purpose other than expressly stated below.

The Taxpayer, Tax Preparer and Requesting Party understand that a separate written consent, signed by the Taxpayer or the Taxpayer's duly authorized agent or fiduciary, must be obtained for each separate use or disclosure.

You are not required to complete this form. If we obtain your signature on this form by conditioning our services on your consent, your consent will not be valid. If you agree to the disclosure of your tax return information, your consent is valid for the amount of time that you specify. If you do not specify the duration of your consent, your consent is valid for one year from the date of signature.
